NOTE:

To be eligible for retiree benefits, you must have at least 10 years of accredited service with BC Hydro, have been covered under BC Hydro's group plan on the day preceding your retirement, and be eligible to receive an immediate pension from BC Hydro. For Extended Health Care, you must be a permanent resident of BC and registered with the Fair PharmaCare program. For Dental, you must be a permanent resident of Canada. Retiree benefits are not guaranteed and coverage and costs are subject to change. The cost of providing the "Extra" plan is reviewed regularly. For more details please refer to the 'your group benefits' booklet issued by Sun Life.
